

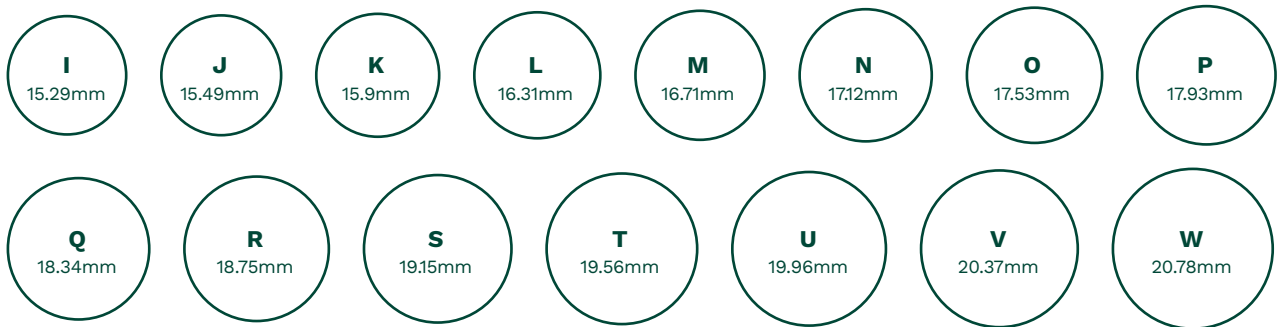
Ring sizing

If you're unsure about your ring size and would like to ensure an accurate and comfortable fit, it's always best to visit your local jeweller. But to help in the meantime we've put together a couple of tools to help you.

Your ring should feel comfortably snug on your finger to avoid being lost, without being too tight. We've compiled several tools which you can use to ensure you achieve the perfect fit first time.

Measure an existing ring

Place a ring you already own on the circles below to compare the internal diameter



Measure your ring finger

- Cut out the ring sizer below, and make a cut along the 'cut slit here' line.
- Pull the thin end through the slit.
- Ensure the guide isn't too tight over your knuckle.
- Read the size that the arrow point to.
